1)	Welcome and Introductions Members in attendance: Gary Kobara, Charlie Lackie, Dianna Lackie, Other in attendance: Nola Engelskirger, County Public Works; Larissa Clark, San Luis Coastal RCD; Karen White, OCSD; Joyce and Dave Tanner (members of the public)
2)	Public Comment – Joyce and Dave Tanner expressed concerns on the cost of the Zone 1 and 1A special tax assessment and annual increases of the special tax assessments.
3)	Announcements – Oceano Community Open House Event Saturday, November 17, 10-1 Oceano Community Center, 1425 19th Street
4)	Review and Approval of Past Minutes No quorum.
5)	Winter Prep & Channel Maintenance <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Flap gate maintenance has been completed. All flap gates were inspected and maintained to remove vegetation and sediment blocking gates for proper operation.• Since the trash removal efforts associated with Coastal Cleanup day, significant amounts of trash are being collected and piled up on top of the levees. We are seeking contractor estimate to come collect and dispose of accumulated trash.• To date, long range forecast indicates equal probability for above normal or below normal precipitation.• Temporary Levee Protection is ready to be installed, if needed. All materials have been inventoried and are available for installation. Labor contracts/reservations for inmate labor are in place.• Annual training for Public Works staff to implement the Emergency Response Plan should levees overtop or fail is scheduled for December 13.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Arroyo Grande Creek Flooding and Evacuation Safety Information brochure is being updated and will be mailed to Oceano residents and businesses in December.
6)	<p>Waterway Management Program Alt 3a/Mod 3c</p> <p>County Staff Nola Engelskirger provided the following project update:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Project is still in final design and permitting phase. We expect to obtain the remaining environmental permits from RWQCB, CA Dept of Fish and Wildlife, and CA Coastal Commission in the next 6 months. Cannon has been hired to update topographic information and prepare easement documents. Cannon is currently working on completing boundary survey so that they can prepare needed easement documents. Staff will be reaching out to property owners in the next few months to start discussions about needed construction easements and permanent easements. On December 11, the District will accept FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant in the amount of \$3M and will executed related grant documents. So far, previously awarded grant funds are expected to stay with the project through completion. Prop 84 and Prop 1 will need to be re-appropriated, which is an internal process through DWR. And, Prop 68 - CDFW Grant Applications are due December 18. This grant could provide funding for planning needed on the AG Creek and Meadow Creek Lagoon Restoration project that is required to meet conditions associated with the Army Corp permit for the WMP project.
